



BCaBA Pathway 2 Coursework Attestation

2022 Coursework Requirements

Overview

This form may be completed by a current Pathway 2 Program Contact for students who have completed at least one course in their designated program. The purpose of this form is to attest that an applicant has met the current coursework requirements for BCaBA certification under Pathway 2.

Instructions

The Pathway 2 Program Contact will:

- Review the following:
 - the current BCaBA coursework requirements (see [BCaBA Pathway 2 Coursework Requirements](#))
 - the student’s syllabi
 - the student’s transcript
 - the [BCBA and BCaBA Pathway 2 Coursework Attestations FAQs](#) document
- Complete this form in its entirety for consideration. Incomplete documents will not be accepted.
- Confirm that the applicant has created a BACB account and provided you with their BACB ID. Please note that the BACB will not provide feedback on this attestation to the applicant until they have submitted a paid BCaBA Certification Application.
- Log in to your BACB portal and navigate to the Coursework Attestation tab. Search for the applicant using their BACB ID. After locating them, fill out the necessary information and upload the completed BCaBA Pathway 2 Coursework Attestation form.
- Keep a copy of this completed form and the supporting documentation for at least 7 years, as the BACB may request this information during an audit.

BCaBA Pathway 2 Coursework Requirements

You must complete behavior-analytic coursework that meets the following requirements:

- The coursework was undergraduate level (i.e., bachelor’s) and was completed at the [qualifying institution](#) in which you were enrolled.
- You received academic credit for the coursework.
- The coursework was obtained within 10 years of the year the application was submitted (e.g., to apply in 2026, only coursework completed in 2016 or later will be applied).
- The coursework reflects that you received a passing grade (“C” or higher in a graded course or “pass” in a pass/fail system) in each course.
- The coursework covers all of the content areas and number of hours specified in this table:

2022 Coursework Content Requirements	
Content Areas	Hours*
BACB Ethics Code and Code-Enforcement System; Professionalism <i>Note: 15 hours must be taught in one or more freestanding courses, meaning that the BACB’s ethics code, code-enforcement system, and professionalism must constitute the majority of each course’s content.</i>	30 hrs
Philosophical Underpinnings; Concepts & Principles	45 hrs
Measurement, Data Display, and Interpretation; Experimental Design	30 hrs
Behavior Assessment	45 hrs
Behavior-Change Procedures; Selecting and Implementing Interventions	60 hrs
Personnel Supervision and Management	15 hrs
Total	225 hrs

* For the purpose of establishing instructional requirements that can be applied globally, 1 semester credit hour will represent 15 hours of classroom instruction, and 1 quarter credit hour will represent 10 hours of classroom instruction. This conversion is based on [US Federal Rule](#).
