

# How to Link to BACB Resources




The BACB uses permanent links, called permalinks, for all resources available on its website. These URLs remain consistent over time, even when the content they point to is updated or replaced. This is important because PDF files and other documents are regularly revised and reposted with new file names and locations. Using the permalink ensures your link always points to the most current version of the resource and avoids broken or outdated links.

Follow these steps to locate and copy the permalink for a BACB resource.

## 1. Find the Permalink


Hover your mouse over the resource link you want to reference. The **permalink should appear** at the bottom of your browser window.

## 2. Copy the Permalink

Right-click the resource link and select the **Copy Link Address**, **Copy Link**, or a similar option in your browser.
